Rev. Orr Oliver Herrington, age 87, of Dallas, Georgia, passed away peacefully Tuesday, November 25, 2014 at his residence.

Rev. Herrington was born in Buford, Georgia on June 14, 1927, the son of the late Arles Smith Herrington and the late Thomas Bell Herrington. For many years he worked as Warehouse Manager for the Kitchen-Hanie Company. Rev. Herrington spent fifty years of his life serving the Lord as a minister of the Gospel, spending thirty seven of those years as pastor of Calvary Congregational Holiness Church in Fayetteville, Georgia. He was a World War II Veteran having served our Country in the United States Navy as a Seaman.

Survivors include his wife of fifty eight years, Joann Henry Herrington, daughter and son-in-law, Dawn and Adam Proux, Dallas, Georgia, son, Tommy Herrington, Buford, Georgia, sons and daughters-in-law, Bruce and Cheryl Herrington, Locust Grove, Georgia and Ricky Lyn Herrington and Dianne Williams, Forest Park, Georgia. Several great grandchildren also survive.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his sons, Randy Herrington and Freddy Huckabee, daughter Sherry Hart, granddaughter, Athena Huckabee and a brother, Larry Herrington.

Funeral Services will be conducted Saturday, November 29, 2014, 1 p.m. from Calvary Congregational Holiness Church in Fayetteville, Georgia with the Reverends Roy Huggins and Joe Kerbow officiating. His body will lie in state at the church from 12:00 until 1:00 p.m. prior to the funeral service.
